GBI's Standard BSR/GBI 01-202x: Green Globes Assessment Protocol for Commercial Buildings is accepting public comments through July 25, 2021

The standard includes criteria and practices for resource-efficient, healthy, resilient, and environmentally preferable new construction of commercial buildings.
